Key Terms:

Insets- The inspired insets in Revelation are often "parenthetical in nature and are included at just the right moment so as to provide a clearer and more complete picture.

The Rapture- Christ will "suddenly remove" the redeemed Church before the Tribulation; (see 1 Thess. 1:9-10; 4:16-17; 1 Cor. 15:51-52; Rev. 3:10)

The Tribulation- "Is a period of divine judgments before the return of Jesus Christ and the establishment of His kingdom on earth;" (Dan. 9:27; Jer. 30:7; Zeph. 1:15; Matt. 24-25; Rev. 6-18).
