For Further Reflection/Application: *James 1:21-25; Psalm 1:1-3; 1 Peter 2:2-3*

When people reject the gospel, do you ever lovingly warn them of the spiritual and eternal consequences of their unbelief? Why did we omit this part of our gospel presentations? See Paul's example in Acts 17:30-31. Note John the Baptist's gospel witness in Matt. 3:1-12. See also Heb. 9:27; John 3:36; Jude 3-18

The preacher talked about believers not being "dishonest car salesmen." What are the practical implications of this metaphor/illustration?

Why & when are you tempted to not disclose the complete message with unbelievers?

What is the critical distinction between the future marriage supper of the Lamb and the great supper of God? How are these two events different?

If we really believe that Rev. 19:17-21 is truly a Divine prophesy, how should it impact our Christian walk, our witness, and our worship? Write down one specific application for each category.

Are you "too proud to beg?" Reflect on 2 Cor. 5:20 and what Pastor Caleb said during the conclusion of this message.

Total victory in Christ. How does this promise/prophesy help believers to persevere to the end?
