For Further Reflection/Application: *Are you coming under the ministry of the Word of God?*

If we could learn and embrace in faith all that Revelation 21-22 says about the glories of heaven how would it impact our daily lives as Christians? How has this series on the eternal privileges of heavenly citizenship (and the glories of heaven) impacted your Christian walk thus far?

“The next time find yourself struggling to apply what the Lord declares in His Word (whatever that might be) remind yourself of these eternal privileges.” What precepts/passages of Scripture are you struggling to submit to and/or to apply right now? How might this series help incentive and motivate greater effort in regards to your pursuit of Christ-like obedience?

What was meant by the statement, “Following the Lord is a no brainer when it’s viewed through the prism of prophetic promises”?

Many patriotic men and women have testified that, “Serving this great nation was one of the great honors of their life.” How should Christian soldiers view their unique calling? Note 2 Timothy 2:3-4; 10-13.
