For Further Reflection/Application: How has God been sanctifying you through His Word?

In what ways did this morning's macro sermon of Revelation 21-22 encourage and/or strengthen your heart, Christian listener? How should an unbeliever respond to the truth that was proclaimed this morning? (Romans 2:4)

How does the Genesis 3 curse impact your life on a day to day basis? How has sin and the curse impacted any vacations you've taken? Answer specifically. Revelation 22:3 Note Genesis 3:14-4:16.

Think about the lyrics to the beloved "Christmas/2nd Coming" carol, "Joy to the World." Consider how this song makes sense in the light of what Scripture teaches concerning Messiah Jesus' 1st and 2nd Coming?

There will be no more sleepless nights, tearful days, or agonizing moments in heaven. Revelation 21:4a, c. Think back on some of the darkest and/or most painful moments/events/trials in your life. How does eternal joy help us to not lose heart on our Christian pilgrimage? Meditate on Romans 15:13; 2 Corinthians 4:16-18.

Many of the great songs on heaven/glory were sung by Christian slaves during the tragic slavery era in the 18th and 19th centuries. Note the hope and joy of future glory- listen to or read the lyrics of Travis' Cottrell's "Soon and Very Soon" Medley. Listen to Jubilant Sykes' version of "a City Called Heaven."

If life below is too good, how might we be tempted in terms of neglecting spiritual things and/or in terms of losing sight of our eternal home? Note Colossians 3:1-14

What was the most difficult funeral that you ever attended and/or planned? How does Revelation 21:4, 7-8; 22:14-15, and Hebrews 2:14-15 impact the way we view life and death?

How does 2 Peter 3:1-13 tie in with what John sees and records in Revelation 21-22?

In what manner will everyday be Christmas (Immanuel 2.0) in glory? Note Revelation 21:22; 21:3; John 1:14/Isaiah 7:14. What do you think of the following biblical principle, "Our very best day on earth below is nothing compared to an ordinary day in heaven above!?!"

How should the heavenly "no more's" help God's people to process and get through national tragedies, seasons of intense religious persecution against believers, and/or personal nightmares? Think about 9-11-01, or the Parkland, Florida shooting, or the religious persecution of Kim Davis, or ______ in the light of this morning's sermon.

"You will stumble occasionally, you may fall occasionally, you may get knocked down occasionally, but always get up facing heaven."
