

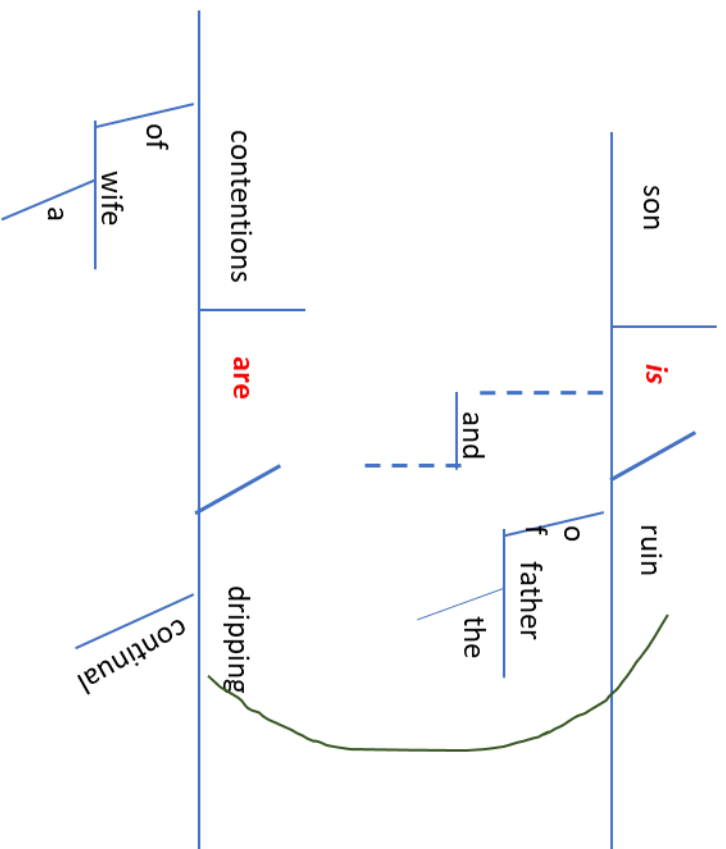
Prov 19:13 (NKJ)

“A foolish son *is* the ruin of his father,

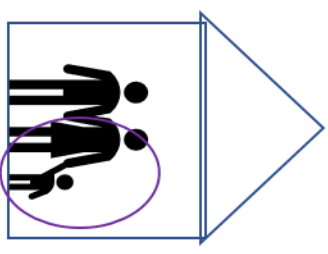
And the contentions of a wife *are* a continual dripping.”

- 2nd line is taken further, bigger application
- Not antithetical or parallel

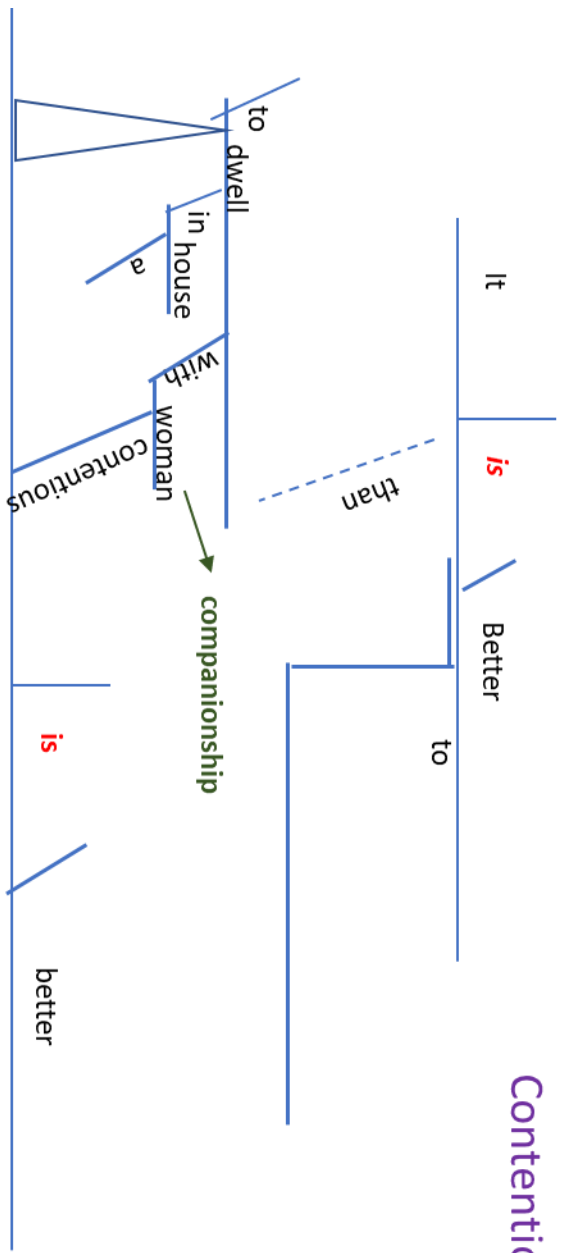


Foolish son = ruin
