brings PROTECTION and PURIFICATION through the blood, CONSECRATION through the meal and PERPETUATION through the ordinance.Put these 4 aspects of the Passover altogether and we see YHWH's; YHWH's Let's look at 12:1-6 before we consider the protection of the blood of the lamb.
1. <u>In YHWH's Passover, the blood has the purpose of PROTECTION.</u> 12:7,13 & 12:21-23
Commentators emphasize that the blood is apotropaic- in that it protects from
We see clearly that the destroyer of vs 23 is of vs12-13 .
BUT, the Judge and DESTROYER in HIS, makes a way for HIS PEOPLE to escape judgement.
