1. We know that Exodus cannot be understood apart from _____, specifically Chs 12/15.
2. We know that God set Moses apart to be His chosen mouthpiece and He did so through intricate _____.
3. We know that HE is the one who initiates for salvation belongs to Him and begins with Him.
4. We know that He made Himself known by _____. He must be true to His nature and Essence therefore He is who He is; He will be who He will be and He is who He was for He is the I AM. His Name is tied to His Covenant Promises, land, nation, seed and blessing.
5. We know there was an earthly leader of the world superpower, Egypt, Pharaoh, who believed himself lord of all, after all he was the embodiment of the god Rah.
6. Yet, we know, it is the LORD'S NAME which *is* and *must be* above all, so the Lord put the might of His Name (all He is) on display in the plagues to show Pharaoh, Egypt, Israel, and the entire earth that He is the I AM.
7. After today's study we'll know that the deliverance of God's people through YHWH's Passover freed them to _____ a righteous Master; the Great I AM.

TODAY, I want to extol the Great I AM as we see YHWH's PASSOVER (the FIRST passover) which brings **PROTECTION** and **PURIFICATION** through the blood, **CONSECRATION** through the meal and **PERPETUATION** through the ordinance. Put these 4 aspects of the Passover altogether and we see YHWH's _____; YHWH's _____.

Let's look at **12:1-6** before we consider the protection of the blood of the lamb.

1. In YHWH's Passover, the blood has the purpose of PROTECTION.

12:7,13 & 12:21-23

Commentators emphasize that the blood is **apotropaic**- in that it protects from _____.

We see clearly that the destroyer of **vs 23** is _____ of **vs12-13**.

2. In YHWH's Passover, the blood has the purpose of PURIFICATION.

3. YHWH's Passover has the purpose of CONSECRATION.
