Now inasmuch as this banner is given to those who fear God, if you fear God, it is given to you. I do not know in what capacity you are to bear it, but I do know there is somewhere or other where you have to carry it. Mother, let the banner wave in your household. Merchant, let the banner be fixed on your house of business. Let it be unfurled and fly at your masthead, oh sailor! Bear the banner, oh soldier in your regiment! Yours is a stern duty, for also the Christian soldier has a path of trial that few men have trodden. May God make you faithful, and may you be honoured as a good soldier of Jesus Christ! Some of you are poor and work hard in the midst of many artisans who do not fear God. Take your banner with you, and never be ashamed of your colours. You cannot be long in a workshop before your companions will pull their colours out. They will soon begin talking to you about their sinful pleasures, their amusements, perhaps their infidel principles. Take your banner out likewise. Tell them that it is a game two can play at; never allow a man to show his banner without showing yours. Do not do it ostentatiously do it humbly, but do it earnestly and sincerely.
