


To help me on to God?


Since I must fight if I would reign, Increase my courage, Lord! I'll bear the toil, endure the pain, Supported by Thy Word. "The destruction of active churches in Romania varied from one case to the next. The purpose, however, was the same: <u>uprooting faith and forcing atheism</u>."

"The result was the exact opposite: instead of diminishing it, the terror strengthened the peoples' faith, and atheism was left as a baseless notion, a characteristic of everything within the Communist Party."

Many endured years in prison before they had even been tried or sentenced.



Over 800,000 people died incarcerated in communist prisons in Romania.



Those who died were often counted as the fortunate ones no longer having to endure the cruel torture.





"Crowbar and chain beatings were frequent occurrences and led to the death of many of the inmates."



In 1964 only 140 remained.


Perhaps the 400 could not be bought or broken.


During these times, the Communists had infiltrated the churches, and even some of the pastors were undercover agents/spies receiving "remuneration" for information.


