For Further Reflection/Application: *Lord help us to be effectually doers of the Word!*

How were you particularly comforted/encouraged/challenged/convicted as you listened to God's Word? What do you want to study further because of this morning's sermon?

When was the last time you were baffled over what was happening in your life and/or in the world around you? When you had no idea what the Lord was up to? When you felt dazed and confused? Review the three main points from today's sermon. When is the last time the Lord (or the Spirit of Christ) ministered to you in your deepest distress turning your sorrow into joy? Note also Psalm 30. How is faith fueled and joy supercharged through answered prayer?

In John 14-16 the disciples are struggling to come to terms with what Jesus said concerning his forthcoming betrayal, death, and departure. What are some reasons they were so upset/afraid/confused?

Evaluate what you've read concerning "the Asbury Revival" with what Jesus has taught us concerning the New Covenant ministry of the Holy Spirit in John 14-16.

What did the preacher mean when he said, "Gloom and doom Christianity is a poor testimony to unbelievers and is terribly self-focused, and very short-sighted?"

We are to live in light of eternity and be Christ-centered (not circumstance-focused). For believers the Gospel reminds us that there's always light at the end of the tunnel!

Jesus implores His followers to trust Him (fully) and to find great comfort, joy, and peace in various promises related to heaven, the New Covenant ministry of the Holy Spirit, His resurrection, future joy, and His second coming. The same message is ours to receive: Trust Jesus (fully) and find comfort in ___.

From sorrow to joy. The cross (sorrow) proceeded the empty tomb/Jesus' bodily resurrection (joy). The ascension of Christ (sorrow); proceeded the outpouring of the Holy Spirit in all His blessed fulness (joy).

Review the lyrics to the hymn, "Stayed Upon Jehovah" AKA "Like a River, Glorious."

William Cowper (1774) wrote; 1 God moves in a mysterious way/His wonders to perform.

He plants his footsteps in the sea/And rides upon the storm.

2 You fearful saints, fresh courage take;/The clouds you so much dread.

Are big with mercy and shall break/In blessings on your head.

3 His purposes will ripen fast,/Unfolding ev'ry hour.

<u>Practical Implications of John 16:12-13a</u>. 1) We can have full confidence in the authority and truthfulness of the New Testament Scriptures. 2) "To Look for some word other than this word, now inscripturated for the church, is to seek some spirit other than the Holy Spirit."
