## For Further Reflection/Application: Lord help us to be effectually doers of the Word!

1 Thess. 5:14 tells Christians that we ought to "encourage the fainthearted" believer. How can you use the precious promises of Christ that are presented in John 14-16 to minister God's Word to a saint that is afraid, discouraged, depressed, or who feels alone?

*When* is trusting and obeying Christ particularly difficult for you? Think about a time when you panicked like the disciples in the Upper Room.

What are some (the lower case "t") tribulations that American Christians might experience in the future? Note John 15:18:19; 16:1-3; Acts 14:19-22. 2 Timothy 3:1-5; 10-17.

How can you as a Christian watch the news and engage the culture without succumbing to sinful anger, fear, or despair? What are some ways Satan might attack your joy?

How can we experience peace (serenity) and courage in the face of spiritual danger? Review the 5 promises of Christ that were summarized in today's message. How might these 5 precious promises comfort the heart of a believer you know that is struggling with fear, worry, and anxiety? How might they comfort someone who is hurting or who feels alone? How might they strengthen our faith and help us to be strong and courageous?

Recall the sermon illustration of the weeping soldier and President Lincoln's son (who provided him with access to his father). In Christ we have direct access to the Father and by extension to the storehouse of heaven. Let us humbly, in faith, "Ask in Jesus' Name!" Lord, help us to be a house of prayer.

The pathway to deep and abiding joy is believing prayer and an obedient and believing heart! God is the fountain of joy (hence John 16:25). How should the promise of peace and joy and hatred and persecution impact your prayer life?

How does the gospel/Christ keep the enemy from robbing us of our joy and peace?

Review the outlines listed on page 3-4 of this sermon handout.

How were you particularly comforted/encouraged/challenged/convicted as you listened to God's Word? What do you want to study further because of this morning's sermon?
