For Further Reflection: Lord help us to be doers of the Word and not just sermon connoisseurs

What's the most important thing that you heard today? How were you encouraged, challenged, and/or convicted? What do you want to study further as a result of listening to today's message?

According to Deuteronomy 18:9-22, what are some of the detestable ways people seek guidance in this dark world? What is a divinely ordained way to receive help and direction? Compare and contrast Deuteronomy 18:9-14 with Deuteronomy. 18:15-19.

How does today's Deuteronomy 18 msg. fit into the current miniseries on "Christ in the OT"? "Moses looked into the future and offered an absolutely reliable source of truth." What Moses' predicted came true (Gal. 4:4-5; Acts 3:17-26) furthering demonstrating that he was a true prophet (and a man of God).

What is Messianic Hope? How has it helped (does it help) God's people endure difficult seasons?

How does the sermon apply to you personally? Also note Matthew 7:28-29; 17:1-8; Hebrews 1-3.

How does this exposition of Deuteronomy 18 relate to Jesus Messianically? Note Acts 3:17-26; 7:36-37.

Luke 3:23-38 must be read against the backdrop of the O.T. Scriptures. The O.T. makes up two-thirds of the Holy Bible. Do you really understand and believe the Old Testament?

How can one use the O.T. while engaging in local outreach and personal evangelism? Could you show an Orthodox Jew that the O.T. clearly points to Jesus using only the O.T. Scriptures?

The trailhead of the Old Testament is unmistakably Messianic. This O.T. sermon series on the Coming Messiah flows out of/into three key texts: John 20:31, Luke 24:44, & John 5:46.

What does it mean to know and believe that Jesus is <u>the</u> Christ? Our Prophet, Priest, and King (note John 20:31 and the sermon from 1/7/24. How might (and/or should) saving faith in the Divine Christ, impact my daily walk this week? Why do all sinners need a Messiah? Why is salvation unattainable apart from Him (John 14:6; 20:31; Acts 4:12)?
